- Explore local services available for target population
 - Pharmaceutical reps re compassion coverage
 - Not-for-profits
 - Community organizations
 - ASOs (AIDS service organizations)



Strategies

- Processing labs through public health
 - Infection screening including STIs (GC, CT, syphilis), plus hep A/B/C, schistosomiasis, strongyloides, toxoplasmosis, CMV
 - Assessing immune status Varicella, MMR, etc.
 - HIV viral load and related including genotype/resistance
 - HLAB5701
